Recommendation

Staff recommends settlement of these workers' compensation claims in the amount of \$22,500 to Gerard Tanelus.

Background

Gerard Tanelus was employed as a Utilities Service Worker with the City until his employment terminated on June 30, 2014. During his eight years with the City, he reported five work related injuries of which three claims remain open. Exposure to the City on the three claims for future medical care and indemnity payments is estimated at \$71,000.

A settlement was reached to resolve the three remaining claims with Mr. Tanelus for a total of \$22,500, subject to the approval of the City Commission. This settlement includes a payment of \$15,420 to Mr. Tanelus and \$7,080 in attorney fees to his attorney.
