Waterways Assistance Program Grant - \$45,095 - (Commission Districts

1, 2, 3 and 4)

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission authorize execution of a grant in the amount of \$45,095 from the Florida Inland Navigation District Waterways Assistance Program.

# **Background**

In March 2023, the City applied to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) for funding through their FY2023 Waterways Assistance Program. The grant program provides funding assistance to local governments to perform waterway improvement projects as well as for the purchase of marine law enforcement related equipment.

The City of Fort Lauderdale submitted a project proposal in the amount of \$90,190 for the purchase of one pair of outboard motors to replace old and malfunctioning engines. Fort Lauderdale has been awarded \$45,095 in FIND funding towards the purchase of the motors. The City will meet the grant's required 50% cash match by funding the balance of the cost in the amount of \$45,095. The grant period is October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2025.

#### **Resource Impact**

The total project cost is \$90,190. There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$45,095, contingent upon the approval of Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 23-0974.
