

RESOLUTION NO. 26-82

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL SURTAX FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE BREAKERS AVENUE RESILIENCY AND TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS SURTAX GRANT MATCH PROGRAM PROJECT (GMFORT-026), AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in November 2018, Broward County voters approved a 30-year sales surtax to fund statutorily-permissible transportation expenditures; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2018, the City Commission adopted a resolution approving a revised Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2025, the City Commission approved a Third Amendment to the Transportation Surtax Interlocal Agreement, which made the City of Fort Lauderdale eligible for the Surtax Grant Match Program ("GMP"); and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2025, Broward County issued a Notice of Award in the amount of \$3,000,000 for the Breakers Avenue Resiliency and Traffic Improvements Project to match a previously secured State appropriation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves an Interlocal Surtax Funding Agreement for City of Fort Lauderdale between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County for the Breakers Avenue Resiliency and Traffic Improvements Surtax Grant Match Program Project (GMFORT-026) ("Interlocal Agreement") in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #26-0405, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement and any required documents associated with the Interlocal Agreement.


SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
