General Grant Terms, Conditions and Understandings :

In addition to the specific terms and conditions in your grant award letter to which these General Grant Terms, Conditions and Understandings are attached, The USTA Florida Section Foundation (the Foundation) is awarding this grant to you as the Grantee contingent upon the following:

Tax-Exempt Status: :

You are a nonprofit organization currently recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as governmental agency or a public charity described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. • Your tax-exempt status has not changed since the issuance of the IRS determination letter which you provided to the Foundation, and • There is no issue presently pending before any office of the IRS that could result in any proposed changes to your tax-exempt status under Sections 501(c)(3) of the Code.

Expenditure of Funds: :

Records and Reports: :

In the case of any violation of the terms and conditions of the grant, including but not limited to failure to execute the work of the grant in substantial compliance with the proposal, or in the event of any change in or challenge by the IRS of your status as a Public charity or Public Facility, the Foundation reserves the right in its absolute discretion to terminate the grant. The Foundation's determination will be final and will be binding and conclusive upon you.

The Foundation reserves the right to review and approve the text of any proposed publicity concerning this grant prior to its release.
