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
THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP



Black Males and the Achievement Gap Achievement gaps among different groups of students are prevalent at the local, state, and national levels. To reach the ambitious educational goals that we have set for all of our students in Broward County Public Schools, the District has formed the Black Male Task Force. The work of the task force will focus on the development of plans and processes for addressing Black Male Success (BMS) in Broward County. Initiatives include creating and sustaining infrastructure for success in education, work, and life, and the utilization of existing entities, organizations, and resources for cross-sector

Task Force Achievement Plan: The BMTF will develop a Zone-wide database, that will be utilized for Task Force identified students that will include data/trends, and will become a resource for academic and service referrals. The achievement plan will provide ongoing documentation as to what services were offered, and the results (utilized / declined (and why) This individual plan will not only help the child, but the school and family overall, as it builds site-based strategies to effectively give a full wrap-around of the total child, and services to help turn the curve both academically, and socially.

Early Years/ Early Childhood - **Springboard:** An early childhood partnership and showcase featuring local Daycare and Pre-K providers in a coalition to prepare students for Elementary school-readiness (early learning and transitional program).

DILLARD TV (Zone-wide Television Show Development): Direct Instruction (Decoding Strategies/ Phonemic Awareness) Monthly/Bi-Monthly VCS/ Distance Learning Coaching Program. - III. College/ Vocational/ Career Pathways: (Coaching Next Steps: In School/Beyond School. Inclusive of in house and community-based coaches)


Effective Communication
