<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby appoints Ms. Parker Jacobson-Bertanzetti as an honorary youth chair to the Sustainability Advisory Board.

SECTION 2. That the appointment will be for a one (1) year term.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.
