

RESOLUTION NO. 25-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING PARKER JACOBSON-BERTANZETTI TO THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD ("SAB") AS AN HONORARY YOUTH CHAIR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, from rising seas to extreme precipitation to increasing temperatures, climate change impacts all residents of Fort Lauderdale, and particularly, our youth; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Sustainability Advisory Board ("SAB") was created to act in an advisory capacity to the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, with regards to environmental sustainability, addressing strategies associated with climate change, sea level rise, resource use, greenhouse gas emissions, conservation, renewable energy and energy efficiency, considering ecological, economic and social equities; and

WHEREAS, since June 2024, Ms. Parker Jacobson-Bertanzetti, a high school junior in Fort Lauderdale, has been attending every SAB meeting and offering input on the topics discussed by SAB; and



SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby appoints Ms. Parker Jacobson-Bertanzetti as an honorary youth chair to the Sustainability Advisory Board.


