TITLE: Resolution Appointing Pat Reilly as the City Auditor, Approving an

Employment Contract - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

## Recommendation

At the meeting of September 22, 2022, the City Commission reached agreement to appoint Pat Reilly as the City Auditor. Staff is providing this resolution approving an Employment Contract with Pat Reilly in substantially the form attached and authorizing the Mayor to execute the Employment Contract.

## **Background**

Subsection 4.14(a) of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides:

The city commission shall appoint a city auditor who shall be employed under such terms and conditions as the city commission may deem advisable. The city auditor shall receive such compensation as the city commission may by resolution fix and designate. The individual appointed to the position of city auditor shall be a person who holds and maintains an active license to practice public accounting pursuant to Chapter 473, Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time, and shall have sufficient experience in governmental accounting and auditing practices.
