

## Scope of Work for Additional T&M Projects Sun-Up Enterprises, Inc.

As part of the City's desire to create "Complete Streets," pedestrian improvements will be completed throughout the City. Improvements will include ADA upgrades, solar-powered flashing beacons, pedestrian crosswalks, refuge areas, pedestrian signalization, on-street parking, milling and resurfacing, sidewalks, installation of bike lanes, and other pedestrian enhancements based on the need of each intersection and corridor. This includes costs for mobilization, maintenance of traffic, and removal of existing infrastructure to accommodate the new enhancements.
