Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the Mayor and City Manager to execute an amendment to the ground lease with Cimarron Bay Investments, IV, LLC, extending the current lease agreement through December 31, 2015

Background

A ground lease with Cimarron Bay Investments, IV, LLC, for the site where Temporary Fire Station 54 will be placed during the construction of the new station commenced on June 1, 2013 and was to continue for a term of 18 months or until the new Fire Station 54 was operational, whichever was sooner. Due to the delay in the land swap for Fire Station 54, staff believes it is in the best interest to extend the term of the ground lease to December 31, 2015 or until the new Fire Station 54 was operational, whichever is sooner.
