TITLE: Motion Approving Piggyback Agreement for DNA Testing for Sexual Assault

Evidence with Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc., Utilizing Maricopa County, Arizona, Contract No. 190294-S - \$72,459.50 - (Commission Districts 1,

2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an Agreement for DNA Testing for Sexual Assault Evidence with Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc., in substantially the form attached, utilizing ("Piggybacking) Maricopa County, Arizona, Contract No. 190294-S in the amount of \$72,459.50, and authorize execution of the Agreement.

Background

In January 2021, the City accepted an award from the Department of Justice's (DOJ) National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI) Competitive Grant program (CAM 21-0023). The purpose of the program is to examine issues related to the handling of sexual assault kits (SAKs), develop, and implement methodology to improve the processing and preservation of quality DNA evidence, and the provision of trauma-informed victim services. Since the inception of the SAKI Grant Program under a FY2018 grant award, detectives have re-opened 61 cold cases and 4 individuals have been charged with sexual assault.

During a recent Evidence Unit Audit, 21 sexual assault kits were identified as in need of DNA testing. There is also one case that will possibly require forensic genetic genealogical DNA analysis. The Police Department has outsourced Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) testing services, as the City does not have its own laboratory to facilitate the described type of procedure. Bode Cellmark Forensics, Inc. (Bode) was selected though a competitive process by the County of Maricopa as one of the outsourcing vendors based on specific criteria recommended by the DOJ and best practices. Bode has previously partnered with the Police Department to facilitate SAK testing. It is accredited by ANSI National Accreditation Board (ANAB) to ISO/IEC 17025:2005, the ASCLD/LAB-International Supplemental Requirements for Forensic Testing Laboratories, as well as the FBI Quality Assurance Standards for Forensic Testing Laboratories and DNA Databasing Laboratories.
