

RESOLUTION NO. 15-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DOWNTOWN FORT LAUDERDALE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION (TMA) FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE, WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF APRIL 1, 2015.

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, authorize the City Manager to execute an Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association (TMA) for the provision of Community Bus services, with an effective date of April 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the ILA between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the TMA to operate the City's Community Bus service, will now include operation of additional routes; and

WHEREAS, the seven routes currently operated by the TMA are the Airport Link, Beach Link, Downtown Link, Galt Link, Las Olas Link, Neighborhood Link, and Tri-Rail/NW Community Link; and

WHEREAS, TMA will commence operation of the Uptown Link beginning April 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the TMA provides multiple transportation programs besides operating as a Transit Agency for the City's Community Bus program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, an Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the TMA for the addition of Uptown Link routes, with an effective date of April 1, 2015.

SECTION 2. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.
