TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Purchase of Disposal Services for
Construction and Demolition Debris – Waste Management Inc. of Florida -
\$839,160 (estimated three-year total)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three-year contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of disposal services for construction and demolition debris from Waste Management Inc. of Florida (WMIF) in the estimated three-year amount of \$839,160; and authorize the City Manager to approve two additional one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

On April 3, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid 873-11922 for disposal services for construction and demolition debris. On bid opening day, April 26, 2017, the City received a total of two bids. The bid from Kita Corp was the lowest bid; however, they declined to move forward due to a clerical error in their proposed bid and could not honor their pricing. WMIF was the second lowest bid. WMIF has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City in the current fiscal year FY 2017. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 2: Be a sustainable and resilient community.
 - Objective 4: Reduce solid waste disposal and increase recycling.
