The City of Fort Lauderdale will amend its 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan for its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) public service program. In accordance with the Substantial Change Policy of the City's HUD-approved Consolidated Plan, any changes in CDBG-assisted activity due to the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, funding allocation, requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan.

The proposed amendment is as follows: Reprogramming CDBG Public Service funds in the amount of \$21,344.00 that was originally awarded to Delta Education and Life Development Foundation, Incorporated, a Florida not for profit corporation. Funds will now be awarded to Habitat for Humanity Broward, Inc., a Florida not for profit corporation, to carry out an economic development activity associated with their first-time homebuyers' program.

City is hereby establishing a thirty (30) day public comment period to receive input on the proposed amendment. Comments on the proposed changes may be submitted to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Housing & Community Development Division, 914 Sistrunk Blvd. Suite #103, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311. Public comments on these items will be accepted during the 30-day public comment period from October 27, 2022, to November 29, 2022. All comments must be received by November 29, 2022.
