TITLE: Motion Approving Funding for Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) Professional Services Library - 12.0 General Structural Engineering - RJ Behar & Company, Inc. - \$500,000 (estimated 3-year total) - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve funding for the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) Professional Services Library - 12.0 General Structural Engineering - Continuing Services Contract with RJ Behar & Company, Inc., in the amount of \$500,000 (estimated 3-year total).

Background

On May 18, 2021, the City Commission awarded an Agreement for general structural engineering services, which was the result of solicitation No. 12464-416. The original agreement only allowed a contract funding of up to \$100,000. Based on a review of anticipated project workloads, an increase is needed for structural engineering inspection, design, and consulting services to facilitate the rehabilitation, repair, and replacement of current and future Community Investment Plan projects, including minor seawall repairs, that are under the CCNA thresholds for both studies and/or construction projects.

Resource Impact

There is a FY 2022 impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$100,000 for the funding award. Funds for this Agreement, in the amount of \$100,000, are available in the FY 2022 Community Investment Plan in the account listed below. Future years' expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
