TITLE: Motion Approving Increase to the Annual Bridge Repair, Maintenance and

Painting Continuing Contracts – Engineer Control Systems Corporation and Lambert Bros., Inc.- \$340,350 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an increase to the Bridge Repair, Maintenance and Painting Continuing Contracts with Engineer Control Systems Corporation (ECS) as primary and Lambert Bros., Inc. (Lambert) as the alternate, by \$340,350 from \$1,500,000 to \$1,840,350.

Background

On August 21, 2018, the City Commission approved two-year agreements for Citywide bridge maintenance services with Engineer Control Systems Corporation and Lambert Bros., Inc., in the amount of \$750,000 (CAM 18-0698). The agreements were approved with two one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds. The described agreements are currently in the second renewal period and will expire on August 26, 2022. Additional bridge projects have been identified and repairs are required on the following bridges: Hendricks Isle Bridge No. 865733, and the Bayview Drive Bridge 856710. City Staff is requesting an increase in the total contract value from \$1,500,000 to \$1,840,350 to perform the additional bridge repairs before the expiration of the agreements.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal year impact to the City in the amount of \$340,350 for this cap increase. Funds for this increase in the amount of \$340,350 are available in the FY 2022 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below.
