TITLE: Motion to approve contract agreement for construction management

services - Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 946-11345 - Consultant

Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract agreement for construction management services for the U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport with ACAI Associates, Inc. and authorize the City Manager to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.

Background

The U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility is currently under construction and is scheduled to be completed by March 2015. To ensure the efficient administering of the construction of the facility, the City prepared an RFQ and Scope of Services to select a construction management firm to provide the following services as outlined in Exhibit A.

In January of 2014, the RFQ was released and five responses were received on February 13, 2014. An evaluation committee was established to review the submittals and shortlist a minimum of three firms for further evaluation. The committee convened on March 3, 2014 and shortlisted the following three firms, listed in alphabetical order:

ACAI Associates, Inc. Atkins North America Calvin Giordano Associates

In March of 2014, the committee held oral presentations with the short-listed firms. After presentations were completed, the committee carefully reviewed the firms and recommended the following rankings:

- 1. ACAI Associates, Inc.
- 2. Atkins North America
- 3. Calvin Giordano & Associates

In May of 2014, the Commission approved the ranking of firms and the commencement of contract negotiation with ACAI Associates, Inc. On May 7, 2014, the Procurement Services Division negotiated pricing with ACAI Associates, Inc. until a final price was agreed upon.

This item was reviewed and approved at the Airport's Aviation Advisory Board meeting held on May 22, 2014.

The initial contract agreement will be for a two-year period with two, one-year extension options subject to City Commission approval.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$137,745.
