**TITLE:** Motion Approving an Outdoor Event Agreement and Request for Road Closure with Twinsplace LLC for Friday Dining in the Streets on the south side of NE 33 Street from State Road A1A to NE 33 Avenue every Friday from February 20, 2026, through and including April 24, 2026 - **(Commission District 1)**

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an outdoor event agreement and request for road closure with Twinsplace LLC, in substantially the form attached, and authorize execution of the agreement by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee.

**Background**

On December 11, 2025, Twinsplace LLC submitted an outdoor event application for Friday Dining in the Streets to be held in front of Blue Jean Blues (3320 NE 33rd Street) on the south side of NE 33 Street from State Road A1A to NE 33 Avenue.

Since 2020, this annual event series has taken place every Friday between the months of November and April. The outdoor event application provides for an event to occur for no more than ninety (90) days, so this application is for the remainder of the planned 2025 - 2026 Friday Dining in the Streets event activations. On October 23, 2025, the City Commission approved an outdoor event agreement for the date range of November 7, 2025, through and including January 30, 2026 (CAM #25-0952).

The event is scheduled from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., every Friday from February 20, 2026, through and including April 24, 2026. Each Friday activation includes the setup period, event period, and breakdown period. The application was submitted within the ninety (90)-day application deadline therefore the outdoor event application fee is \$1,000.

This event organizer is requesting the following special permission that requires City Commission approval:

- Road Closure - The south side of NE 33 Street from State Road A1A to NE 33 Avenue

The event organizer attended the January 21, 2026, outdoor events meeting to review the event details with City staff, including the Parks and Recreation Department, Transportation and Mobility Department, Police Department, and Fire Department. The outdoor events meeting focuses on operational logistics, cross departmental coordination, and event organizer requirements.

City staff invited the surrounding civic associations to the outdoor events meeting as well as shared a copy of the application and site plan. Upon approval, the City’s online events calendar will be updated to reflect this event.

The event agreement defines the responsibilities of the event organizer such as covering the associated event expenses and the required certificates of insurance. The event organizer will also secure all other necessary permits and licenses that are required from other agencies. Authorization for the execution of the event agreement is contingent upon the City Attorney’s Office reviewing and approving as to form all documents prior to execution by the City Manager or designee.
