TITLE: Resolution Extending the Termination Date of the Fire-Rescue Advisory Committee to December 31, 2026 – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution extending the termination date of the Fire-Rescue Advisory Committee to December 31, 2026.

Background

On December 20, 2022, the City Commission adopted Resolution 22-1143 creating the Fire-Rescue Advisory Committee (FRAC), for a term of 24 months (December 31, 2024). The Committee was formed to provide the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale community driven feedback and advise on future planning for the Department's growth and review industry standards and department performance measures.

At the September 9, 2024, meeting, the FRAC unanimously voted to send a communication to the City Commission requesting to extend the committee's efforts to the end of December 2026, allowing the committee to continue its role to provide the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale community driven feedback, and advise on future planning for the Department's growth and review industry standards and department performance measures.

At the November 7, 2024, Commission Conference meeting, the City Commission requested to extend the termination date of the FRAC for an additional 24 months to continue its efforts.
