Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Electro-Mechanic, Inc. d/b/a Vermana for swimming pool resurfacing services at the Riverland Pool and the Lauderdale Manors Pool for a total contract amount of \$364,332, and authorize the City Manager to execute said Agreement.

Background

The Riverland Pool opened in 2005 and the Lauderdale Manors Pool opened in 2000, and the surfaces at both pools are deteriorating, pitting, and delaminating. This will be the first time Riverland Pool and Lauderdale Manors Pool will be resurfaced.

On July 28, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued an Invitation to Bid, Event No. 155, for the purchase of Swimming Pool Resurfacing Services. On August 11, 2023, the event closed and the City received a total of two (2) bid submissions. The bid submitted by Electro-Mechanic Industries, Inc. d/b/a Vermana (Vermana) complied with the bid requirements. Vermana is deemed the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder and recommended for award. Vermana indicates its status as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE).

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$364,332 for the contract award. Funds in the amount of \$364,332 are available in the account listed below.
