

RESOLUTION NO. 26-103

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A GRANT AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL GRANT PROGRAM TO UPDATE THE CITY'S VISION ZERO PLAN, CONDUCT ROAD SAFETY AUDITS AND COMPLETE CORRIDOR CONCEPT PLANS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$392,000; DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY OR INCIDENTAL TO ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH GRANT FUNDING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2015 Vision Zero Plan is a holistic safety action plan that works towards eliminating traffic fatalities or serious injuries on streets within the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"); and

WHEREAS, the City submitted a proposal to the United States Department of Transportation Florida Highway Administration ("FHWA") for grant funding through the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant to update the City's Vision Zero Plan, complete Road Safety Audits of four (4) corridors, and complete Corridor Concept Plans on two (2) corridors for safety improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City's Vision Zero planning efforts are a supplement to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's Broward Safety Action plan, completed and funded through the SS4A Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, in September 2024, the City was notified by the FHWA that the City's application for grant funds was reviewed and that the sum \$392,000 is awarded to the City for the City of Fort Lauderdale's Vision Zero Plan, Road Safety Audits and Corridor Concept Plans; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A grant requires a twenty percent (20%) match of \$98,000, for a total project cost of \$490,000; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to enter into a federal award grant agreement with the FHWA, to accept and receive the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that approving the grant agreement, authorizing the execution of the grant agreement, and acceptance of the grant funds is in the best interest of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the grant agreement with the United States Department of Transportation for the Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program to update the City's Vision Zero Plan, conduct Road Safety Audits and complete Corridor Concept Plans, in the amount of \$392,000 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement, and any documents necessary or incidental thereto and accept the grant funds on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

SECTION 3. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.


SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.
