**TITLE**: Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Replacement at 301 Lido Drive - \$2,960,079

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract in the amount of \$2,960,079 for Sanitary Sewer Pump Station Replacement (D-37) at 301 Lido Drive to the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder, Metro Equipment Service, Inc.

## **Background**

The scope of work requires the contractor to construct a pump station to replace the existing station. D-37 is a master station that serves as the collection point for all of the finger isles off of East Las Olas Boulevard; the station is a critical part of the City's sanitary sewer infractructure.

Invitation to Bid 243-11422 was released on October 1, 2014 and two responses were received. It was determined that Metro Equipment Service, Inc. is the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$2,960,079.

# Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$2,960,079 for the contract and \$296,008 for estimated engineering fees, or a total of \$3,256,087.
