

RESOLUTION NO. 3831

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DULY APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF THE WAR MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE TO EXECUTE RENTAL CONTRACTS FOR THE USE OF SAID AUDITORIUM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission did, on May 23, 1949, adopt a Resolution appointing Howard O. Pierce Director of the War Memorial Auditorium, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has heretofore approved the form of rental contracts to be used in the leasing of the War Memorial Auditorium, and fixed minimum fee rentals, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission to authorize its Director of the War Memorial Auditorium to execute lease contracts with persons, firms or corporations desiring to use said Auditorium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the duly appointed Director of the War Memorial Auditorium be, and he is, hereby authorized to execute rental contracts for and on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the use of said auditorium.

SECTION 2: That such contracts executed by the Director shall not be for less than the minimum fees fixed by the City Commission and such contracts shall be in such form as has heretofore been adopted and approved by the City Commission.
