

RESOLUTION NO. 23-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE COMMISSION LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE'S 2024 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE ANY SUBSEQUENT CHANGES TO THE CITY'S 2024 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM FOR THE DURATION OF THE 2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Government Affairs & Economic Development Manager and contracted state legislative and executive branch representatives will advocate and lobby for the City of Fort Lauderdale's interests during the upcoming legislative session in Tallahassee, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2023, the City Commission approved and adopted the City's 2024 State Legislative Program excluding its Commission Legislative Priorities component;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves and adopts the Commission Legislative Priorities component of the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2024 State Legislative Program as set forth in Exhibit 1 to City Commission Agenda Memo No. 23-1140.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized to approve any subsequent changes to the City's 2024 State Legislative Program for the duration of the 2024 Legislative Session.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
