Addendum #5

This Addendum #5 ("Addendum") specifies additional work to the visionLive™ On-Premise Subscription Services Agreement executed by Vision Internet Providers, Inc., on January 20, 2014, ("Agreement"), between the City of Fort Lauderdale ("Client") and Vision Internet Providers, Inc. ("Contractor"). Client desires Contractor to perform work specified in Addendum #5 Scope of Services ("Scope"), attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

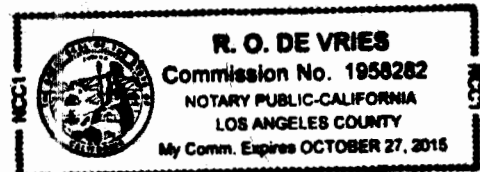

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THIS FORM

Addendum #5 Scope of Services

FXE Portal with Responsive Design - \$12,560.25

A FXE Portal would provide the FXE with its own individualized and attractive homepage. This includes a unique navigation and design that draws on a team while maintaining a layout consistent with the main site to keep the subsite easy to use and navigate for your visitors. However, while there would be consistency in your websites FXE Portal could have its own unique look and navigation structure.

The FXE Portal will provide the same functionality as your main City website since it will use the same backend and have the same interactive components. This means that there is a single Vision Content Management System (VCMS) where all content is stored. Through the use of the Approval Cycle each organization would have access to their own content but could also share content, such as calendar and news items.

Vision Internet will also migrate up to 25 pages of content into the FXE Portal; additional pages may be migrated for an additional budget. Additionally, we are including consultation meetings conducted via WebEx to ensure that the FXE Portal meets your standards. Please note that Responsive Design features are included with the FXE Portal.

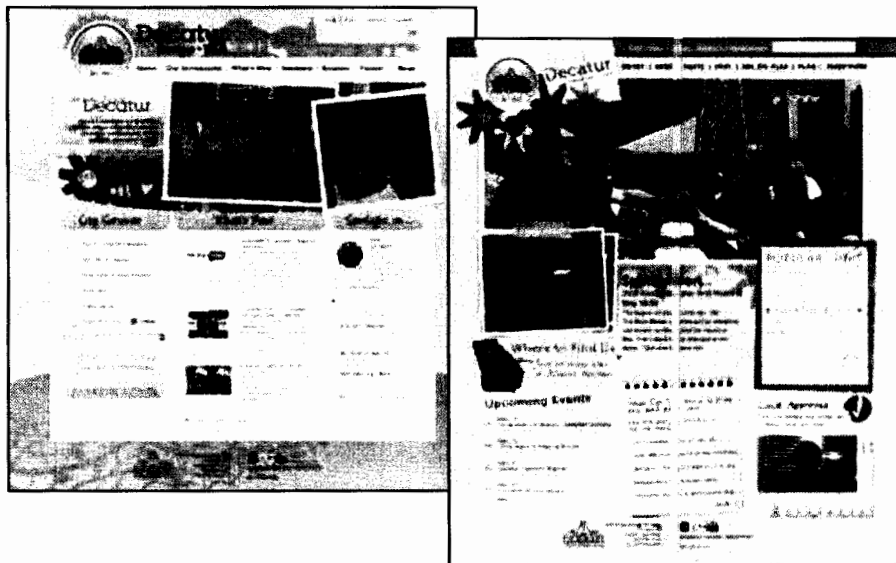
