TITLE: Motion to approve the proprietary purchase of Panoptra software and configuration services in the amount of \$43,600

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the proprietary purchase of Panoptra software in the annual amount of \$35,000 and a one-time purchase of configuration services in the amount of \$8,600, for a total amount of \$43,600, from Enstoa, Inc., and authorize the City Manager to approve annual renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

On June 18, 2014, (CAM 13-0892) the City Commission approved the purchase of unifier project and asset management software from the single bidder, Enstoa, Inc. The purchase included a maintenance component. For the unifier project, Panoptra will allow engineering staff to produce and display custom reports in a variety of ways to aid with decision making and reporting. Additionally, Panoptra will provide staff with the ability to easily extract, display, and analyze project data from the unifier tool; this will allow for the improvement of monitoring and control of projects.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the amount of \$43,600. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
