**TITLE**: Motion to award the proprietary contract for consulting services for Fire-

Rescue Department Accreditation - \$59,500

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a proprietary contract for consulting services for facilitation and preparation of documents necessary for the Fire-Rescue Department to obtain accredited agency status, and authorize execution by the proper City officials, in substantially the form attached, with the Center for Public Safety Excellence, Inc. (CPSE), in the amount of \$59,500.

### Background

Accreditation is a comprehensive self-assessment and evaluation model that enables organizations to examine past, current, and future service levels and internal performance and compare them to industry best practices. This process also leads to improved service delivery. The CPSE is the accrediting agency and offers a technical advisor program that assists agencies in the facilitation of a community based strategic plan (specific to fire department needs), a standard of cover/risk assessment, and a comprehensive self-assessment. We are recommending the award of the proprietary services in accordance with the Code of Ordinances section 2-189.c.4, as a non-profit agency.

### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$59,500.
