ORDINANCE NO. C-24-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, THE NON-BARGAINING-UNIT FLORIDA. AMENDING CLASSIFICATION TABLE OF THE PAY PLAN OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AS AMENDED, BY CREATING AND ADDING TWO JOB CLASSIFICATIONS AND CHANGING THE PAY GRADES OF TWO JOB CLASSIFICATIONS. AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director - Human Resources recommend amending the Non-Bargaining-Unit Classification Table of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, as amended, by adding two new job classifications and changing the pay grades of two job classifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Exhibit 4, Classification Table, Non-Bargaining-Unit, of Ordinance C-18-37, the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, as amended, is hereby amended by creating and adding in alphabetical order by title, two job classifications, to wit:
