TITLE: Motion Approving Execution of a Subgrant Agreement with the Broward

State Attorney's Office for Work Performed Under the Local Law Enforcement Crime Gun Intelligence Center Integration Program Grant -

(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve the execution of a Subgrant Agreement with the Broward State Attorney's Office (Broward SAO) for work performed under the Local Law Enforcement Crime Gun Intelligence Center Integration Program Grant (CGIC).

Background

In June 2021, the City submitted an application to the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to address the incidents of serious violent crimes involving the use of illegal firearms. The City Commission accepted an award of \$466,263 in funding to institute a collaborative project with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, the Department of Corrections, Probation and Parole and the Broward State Attorney's Office to counter a precipitous increase in gun-related violent crime in identified hot spots. The proposed project will expand ShotSpotter program coverage, provide overtime and training for detectives and crime analysts, and facilitate the acquisition of forensic equipment. A condition of the grant requires that 20% of the grant award be allocated to our local prosecutorial partner. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department (FLPD) desires to execute a subgrant agreement with the Broward SAO to compensate their office for work performed by their personnel related to the prosecution of criminal cases that result from FLPD's CGIC investigations.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City. Reimbursement of eligible Broward SAO personnel expenses will be funded by the FY21 CGIC grant, in accordance with applicable federal guidelines.
