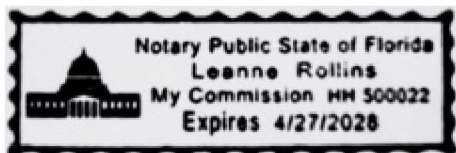

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO
REVIEW AND APPROVE AFFORDABLE
HOUSING INCENTIVE STRATEGIES
REPORT**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, in compliance with Section 420.9076, Florida Statutes, as amended, each municipality participating in the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program must establish an Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) with at least eight (8) members, but no more than eleven (11) members, and specify the membership terms. Pursuant to Section 420.9076(5), Florida Statutes, as amended, the AHAC is required to annually review and approve an affordable housing incentive strategies report during a duly advertised public hearing and, thereafter, submit its recommended affordable housing incentive strategies report to the City of Fort Lauderdale Commission for its consideration and final approval, and send the final approved report to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation. The public is invited to participate and provide comments before the AHAC at a public hearing on September 9, 2024, to review and approve the affordable housing incentive strategies.

The Public Meeting for the AHAC to review and recommend a tentative report for affordable housing incentive strategies will be held at:

The AHAC's Report Summary will evaluate the implementation of Affordable Housing Incentives in the following areas as per Section 420.9076(4) (a-k), Florida Statutes, as amended:

- a. The processing of approval of development orders or permits, as defined in Section 163.3177(6)(f)3., Florida Statutes, as amended, for affordable housing projects is expedited to a greater degree than other projects.
- b. The modification of impact-fee requirements, including reduction or waiver of fees and alternative methods of fee payment for affordable housing.
- c. The allowance of flexibility in densities

for affordable housing.

d. The reservation of infrastructure capacity for housing for very-low-income persons, low-income persons, and moderate-income persons.

e. The allowance of affordable accessory residential units in residential zoning districts.

f. The reduction of parking and setback requirements for affordable housing.

g. The allowance of flexible lot configurations, including zero-lot-line configurations for affordable housing.

h. The modification of street requirements for affordable housing.

i. The establishment of a process by which a local government considers, before adoption, policies, procedures, ordinances, regulations, or plan provisions that increase the cost of housing.

j. The preparation of a printed inventory of locally owned public lands suitable for affordable housing.

k. The support of development near transportation hubs and major employment centers and mixed-use developments.
