WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 15-197, adopted on September 8, 2015, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted the Final Operating Budget, Community Investment Plan and Personnel Complement of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2016, is hereby amended by appropriating funds as set forth in Commission Agenda Memo #16-1142, copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Year 2016 – Appropriation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget.

Background

Examples of recommended actions within the budget amendment are:

- transfer between funds:
- transfer between capital and operating budgets;
- transfer between capital projects;
- acceptance and appropriation of grant funding;
- amendment to staffing level;
- appropriation from fund balance; and
- appropriation for modified revenue and related expenditures.

Staff is recommending that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Operating Budget and personnel complement by approving the following transfers and appropriations:

Parks and Recreation

A. Appropriation of Grant Funds – Grant Funds – Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) Grant Reimbursement - \$16,125

On June 2, 2016 a 60 foot sailing vessel, Zeus, was abandoned and sank on the Intracoastal Waterway creating an environmental and navigational hazard as well as causing damage to private residential property. The vessel was deemed derelict by the City of Fort Lauderdale Marine Police and was removed by a salvage and disposal contractor on June 14, 2016 at a total cost to the City of \$21,500.

The City applied to FIND for funding assistance and was awarded funding up to \$16,125, or 75% of salvage/disposal costs of the project. The remaining cost of \$5,375 to remove the vessel will be paid from the Broward Boating Improvement Grant which was awarded to the City in 2014. This item is contingent upon approval of CAM #16-1075.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Grants Fund in the amount of \$16,125 for the FIND grant reimbursement.

City Manager

B. Transfer of Funds from General Fund Operating to General Capital Projects Fund – General Fund – 7th Floor Renovation - \$90,000

To improve space allocation on the 7th floor of City Hall for the City Manager, City Clerk, and City Attorney's staff, renovations are required. Funds are available in the FY 2016 operating budget to fund this Community Investment Plan project.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2016 Budget and Community Investment Plan by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Fund and General Capital Fund in the amount of \$90,000 for the 7th Floor Renovation project.
