#### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a Construction Agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the Parking Lot Improvements at Nautical Parking Lot with Sagaris Corp., in the amount of \$235,035.

## **Background**

The Nautical Parking Lot is located at 985 SE 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the milling and resurfacing of the parking lot with asphalt, new thermoplastic pavement markings, wheel stop replacement, leveling of existing asphalt pavement, as well as landscaping and irrigation improvements.

On October 23, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 201. The City received the following two (2) bids in response to the solicitation, which was opened on, November 21, 2023:

- Florida Blacktop, Inc. \$229,987
- Sagaris Corp. \$229,035

This firm has been reviewed for compliance with the solicitation requirements. Sagaris Corp. met all the solicitation requirements of the ITB and was deemed the low responsive, and responsible bidder.
