TITLE: Resolution Approving the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement
between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale for Community
Shuttle Service – **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve a resolution approving the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between Broward County (County) and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) for Community Shuttle Service, in substantially the form attached, and authorize the City Manager to execute the Fourth Amendment.

Background

On October 23, 2019, the City and County entered the Interlocal Agreement for the City to provide Community Shuttle Service.

The First Amendment, dated August 4, 2020, removed the wave and ride option, removed advertisements, and removed fares.

The Second Amendment, dated February 22, 2021, adjusted the funding to reflect the rate in the City's agreement with its vendor and amended the vehicle list to reflect the vehicles utilized to provide service.

The Third Amendment, dated June 16, 2021, adjusted the funding to reflect the rate provided for in the City's agreement with its vendor and modified the vehicle list to reflect the vehicles utilized for service.

The proposed Fourth Amendment will:

1. Reimburse the City for incurred operating costs that exceeded available funding from January 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023;
2. Revise route schedules to account for previously approved service enhancements (New Exhibit A);
3. Amend the list of Leased Vehicles to account for an additional vehicle (Amended Exhibit D);
4. Establish operating funding for FY2024 (New Exhibit F); and

5. Add provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

The Fourth Amendment will increase the maximum reimbursement amount provided by the County for the operation of Community Shuttle Service from \$909,000 during FY23 to up to \$1,557,815 during FY24. This additional funding will be used to cover the expansion of service hours for the Beach Link and the Downtown Link (additional 2.5 hour per operating day for each route); the Las Olas Link (additional 3.5 hours per operating day); and an additional vehicle for the Neighborhood Link.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action as the additional revenues are being reimbursed for the additional expenditures.

Strategic Connections

This item is a 2024 *Commission Priority*, advancing the Transportation and Traffic initiative.

This item supports the *Press Play Fort Lauderdale 2029* Strategic Plan, specifically advancing:

- The Infrastructure and Resilience Focus Area, Goal 4: Facilitate an efficient, multimodal transportation network.

RESOLUTION NO. 24-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR COMMUNITY SHUTTLE SERVICE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; TO REPLACE EXHIBIT "A" REGARDING REVISED ROUTE SCHEDULES; TO AMEND EXHIBIT "D" TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL LEASED VEHICLE; TO REPLACE EXHIBIT "F" TO ESTABLISH OPERATING FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024; TO INCLUDE REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR OPERATING COSTS INCURRED FROM JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 AND TO ADD PROVISIONS REGARDING PROHIBITED TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND CRIMINAL HISTORY SCREENING PRACTICES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City") and Broward County ("County") entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") to provide community shuttle service within the City, effective on October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2020, the parties executed a First Amendment to the ILA to modify Exhibit "A" of the ILA, to remove the fares for the Beach Link and Las Olas Link, remove the advertisements, and designate specific stops for the community shuttles; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, the parties executed a Second Amendment to the ILA to modify Exhibit "D", to reflect a change to the list of the vehicles that are being utilized to provide the community shuttle service, and to delete and replace Exhibit "F", which reflects the adjusted operating funding due to the rate change in the City's agreement with its Subcontractor; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2021, the parties executed a Third Amendment to the ILA to adjust the funding to reflect the provided rate, in the City's agreement, with its vendor and modify the vehicle list to reflect the vehicles utilized for service; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter into a Fourth Amendment to the ILA to modify Exhibit "A" to reflect the revised route schedules and to account for previously approved enhancements; to modify Exhibit "D" to reflect an additional leased vehicle; to replace Exhibit "F"

establishing the Fiscal Year 2024 operating fund; to account for the reimbursement to the City for additional operating costs that were incurred and exceeded available funding from January 1, 2022 though September 30, 2023; and to add provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices; and

WHEREAS, the Fourth Amendment will increase the maximum reimbursement amount provided by Broward County for the operation of Community Shuttle Service from \$909,000 during Fiscal Year 2023, to up to \$1,557,815 during Fiscal Year 2024;

WHEREAS, the additional funding will be used to cover the expansion of service hours for the Beach Link and the Downtown Link to an additional 2.5 hours per operating day for each route, the Las Olas Link to an additional 3.5 hours per operating day, and an additional vehicle for the Neighborhood Link.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for Community Shuttle Service and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County to replace Exhibit "A", amend Exhibit "D", and replace Exhibit "F", to establish operating funding for Fiscal Year 2024, to include reimbursement to the City of Fort Lauderdale for operating costs incurred from January 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 and to add provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

SECTION 3. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its final passage and adoption.

**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
BROWARD COUNTY AND CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE
FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE**

This Fourth Amendment ("Fourth Amendment") is entered into by and between Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County"), and the City of Fort Lauderdale, a municipal corporation located in Broward County, Florida ("City") (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

RECITALS

A. The Parties entered into the Interlocal Agreement, dated October 23, 2019 (the "Original Agreement"), for the City to provide Community Shuttle Service.

B. The Original Agreement was amended by a First Amendment, dated August 4, 2020, which modified Exhibit A to include specific times and stops and remove the wave and ride option, remove advertisements, and remove fares; a Second Amendment, dated February 22, 2021, which adjusted the funding to reflect the rate in the City's agreement with its new Subcontractor and amended the vehicles list to reflect the vehicles utilized to provide service; and a Third Amendment dated June 16, 2021, which adjusted the funding to reflect the rate provided for in the City's agreement with its vendor and to modify the vehicle list to reflect the vehicles utilized to provide service. The Original Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment, the Second Amendment, and Third Amendment is referred to herein as the "Agreement."

C. The Parties now desire to further amend the Agreement to retroactively increase County funding to the City for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023, revise route schedules for new service that was approved on January 5, 2022, amend the list of Leased Vehicles utilized by the City, and add certain provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference. All capitalized terms not expressly defined within this Fourth Amendment shall retain the meaning ascribed to such terms in the Agreement.
2. Amendments to specific language in the Agreement made pursuant to this Fourth Amendment are indicated herein by use of strikethroughs to indicate deletions and bold/underlining to indicate additions. Except as modified herein, all remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Exhibit A is hereby deleted and replaced with the attached Exhibit A.

4. Exhibit D is hereby amended as indicated in the attached Exhibit D.
5. Revised Exhibit F is hereby deleted and replaced with the attached Exhibit F.
6. New Sections 11.23 and 11.24 are added to the Agreement as follows (bold/underlining omitted):

11.23 Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment. City represents and certifies that its Subcontractor does not use any equipment, system, or service that uses covered telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system, as such terms are used in 48 CFR §§ 52.204-24 through 52.204-26. City shall require its Subcontractor to represent and certify that the Subcontractor shall not provide or use such covered telecommunications equipment, system, or services during the Term.

11.24 Criminal History Screening Practices. If this Agreement is subject to the requirements of Section 26-125(d) of the Code, City represents and certifies that City and its Subcontractor will comply with Section 26-125(d) of the Code for the duration of the Term.

7. County will make a one-time payment to City in the amount of Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-one and 41/100 Dollars (\$710,821.41) for reimbursement of City's incurred operating costs that exceeded prior County funding covering the period from January 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023.

8. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity between this Fourth Amendment and the Agreement, the Parties agree that this Fourth Amendment shall control. The Agreement, as amended herein by this Fourth Amendment, incorporates and includes all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements, and understandings applicable to the matters contained herein, and the Parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements, or understandings concerning the subject matter hereof that are not contained in the Agreement as amended in this Fourth Amendment. Accordingly, the Parties agree that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representations or agreements, whether oral or written.

9. Preparation of this Fourth Amendment has been a joint effort of the Parties and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial construction, be construed more severely against one of the Parties than any other.

10. City acknowledges that through the date this Fourth Amendment is executed by City, City has no claims or disputes against County with respect to any of the matters covered by the Agreement.

11. The effective date of this Fourth Amendment shall be the date of complete execution by the Parties.

12. This Fourth Amendment may be executed in counterparts, whether signed physically or electronically, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same agreement.



The City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the City of Fort Lauderdale Community Shuttle Routes. The community shuttle service will increase the number of destinations and provide a way that can be reached through public transit. Destinations along the Fort Lauderdale Beach Link Route include: Fort Lauderdale Beach, Broward Health Medical Center, Harbor Shops, Broward County Convention Center, Port Everglades, International Swimming Hall of Fame, Boreet House Museum and Gardens, Hugh Taylor Birch State Park, Galleria Mall, access to hotels, shops and restaurants along A1A, and surrounding neighborhoods.

Connections are available to BCT routes 1, 11, 28, 40, 101, Community Shuttle Route connection to Downtown Link and Beach Link, Broward Water Trolley Route connection.

All routes in this route are air conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instruction on how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

The Fort Lauderdale Beach Link Route is free of charge, but riders making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fare.

BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on the Fort Lauderdale Community Shuttle. Bike racks are designed to carry five bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the shuttle approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

- Loading**
- Always load your bike from the outside of the street
 - Lower - Squares the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
 - Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the shuttle
 - Lock-A-Joad retracts the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.
- Unloading**
- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
 - Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack.
 - If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
 - Move quickly to the curb.
