



## **FOURTH AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE**

This Fourth Amendment ("Fourth Amendment") is entered into by and between Broward County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County"), and the City of Fort Lauderdale, a municipal corporation located in Broward County, Florida ("City") (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

### **RECITALS**

A. The Parties entered into the Interlocal Agreement, dated October 23, 2019 (the "Original Agreement"), for the City to provide Community Shuttle Service.

B. The Original Agreement was amended by a First Amendment, dated August 4, 2020, which modified Exhibit A to include specific times and stops and remove the wave and ride option, remove advertisements, and remove fares; a Second Amendment, dated February 22, 2021, which adjusted the funding to reflect the rate in the City's agreement with its new Subcontractor and amended the vehicles list to reflect the vehicles utilized to provide service; and a Third Amendment dated June 16, 2021, which adjusted the funding to reflect the rate provided for in the City's agreement with its vendor and to modify the vehicle list to reflect the vehicles utilized to provide service. The Original Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment, the Second Amendment, and Third Amendment is referred to herein as the "Agreement."

C. The Parties now desire to further amend the Agreement to retroactively increase County funding to the City for Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023, revise route schedules for new service that was approved on January 5, 2022, amend the list of Leased Vehicles utilized by the City, and add certain provisions regarding Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment and Criminal History Screening Practices.

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference. All capitalized terms not expressly defined within this Fourth Amendment shall retain the meaning ascribed to such terms in the Agreement.

2. Amendments to specific language in the Agreement made pursuant to this Fourth Amendment are indicated herein by use of strikethroughs to indicate deletions and bold/underlining to indicate additions. Except as modified herein, all remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Exhibit A is hereby deleted and replaced with the attached Exhibit A.

4. Exhibit D is hereby amended as indicated in the attached Exhibit D.
5. Revised Exhibit F is hereby deleted and replaced with the attached Exhibit F.
6. New Sections 11.23 and 11.24 are added to the Agreement as follows (bold/underlining omitted):

**11.23 Prohibited Telecommunications Equipment.** City represents and certifies that its Subcontractor does not use any equipment, system, or service that uses covered telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system, as such terms are used in 48 CFR §§ 52.204-24 through 52.204-26. City shall require its Subcontractor to represent and certify that the Subcontractor shall not provide or use such covered telecommunications equipment, system, or services during the Term.

**11.24 Criminal History Screening Practices.** If this Agreement is subject to the requirements of Section 26-125(d) of the Code, City represents and certifies that City and its Subcontractor will comply with Section 26-125(d) of the Code for the duration of the Term.

7. County will make a one-time payment to City in the amount of Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-one and 41/100 Dollars (\$710,821.41) for reimbursement of City's incurred operating costs that exceeded prior County funding covering the period from January 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023.

8. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity between this Fourth Amendment and the Agreement, the Parties agree that this Fourth Amendment shall control. The Agreement, as amended herein by this Fourth Amendment, incorporates and includes all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements, and understandings applicable to the matters contained herein, and the Parties agree that there are no commitments, agreements, or understandings concerning the subject matter hereof that are not contained in the Agreement as amended in this Fourth Amendment. Accordingly, the Parties agree that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon any prior representations or agreements, whether oral or written.

9. Preparation of this Fourth Amendment has been a joint effort of the Parties and the resulting document shall not, solely as a matter of judicial construction, be construed more severely against one of the Parties than any other.

10. City acknowledges that through the date this Fourth Amendment is executed by City, City has no claims or disputes against County with respect to any of the matters covered by the Agreement.

11. The effective date of this Fourth Amendment shall be the date of complete execution by the Parties.

12. This Fourth Amendment may be executed in counterparts, whether signed physically or electronically, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same agreement.





### CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE BEACH LINK COMMUNITY SHUTTLE ROUTE (SUNDAY)

The City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County, Transit (BCT), have partnered to provide the Ft. Lauderdale Community Shuttle Routes. This community shuttle service will provide the number of departures and arrival times that can be reached through public transit. General area along the Ft. Lauderdale BEACH LINK Route include Ft. Lauderdale Beach, Las Olas Boulevard, Las Olas Riverfront, Harbor Grace, International Shopping Mall at Las Olas, Everglades International Shopping Center, Port Everglades, International Swimming Hall of Fame, Burrell House Museum and Gardens, Hugh Taylor Birch State Park, Salena Mall, access to hotels, shops and restaurants along AIA, and surrounding neighborhood.

Connections are available at BCT routes 1, 11, 20, 40, 531, Community Shuttle Route connection, BCT 4000 Link and BeachLink. BeachLink Water Taxi Route connection. All shuttles in this route are air conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to the pamphlet for instruction on how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

The Ft. Lauderdale BEACH LINK Route is free of charge, but users making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the applicable fare.

#### HOURS OF OPERATION Sunday

##### BEACH LINK Route: 9:30 am - 6:00 pm

The Ft. Lauderdale BEACH LINK Route operates approximately every 25 minutes, with designated stops and schedules. Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The shuttle will operate at 9:30 AM Monday through Friday. If there is a severe weather warning or if other factors do not allow for the safe operation of the shuttle. To track the shuttle in real time, please download the mobile app LauderGO! or download the mobile app.

#### HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Fri 1 Lauderdale BEACH LINK Route (not available on the following holidays observed by the City of Fort Lauderdale:

- \* Thanksgiving Day
- \* Christmas Day

#### BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on the Ft. Lauderdale Community Shuttle. Bike racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's armrests before loading and unloading your bike. As far as the appropriate, have your bike ready to load. Please note any local laws that may affect you.

#### Loading

- \* Always load your bike from the outside of the shuttle.
- \* Lower Squares the handle and pull down to release the loaded bike rack.
- \* Lift your bike into the rack. Align the wheel to the slot of the instant position closest to the shuttle.
- \* Push/Roll the support arm over the front tire, holding the support arm resting on the front tire until the support arm is resting on the rear tire.

#### Unloading

- \* Always unload, only the operator you are removing your bike.
- \* Put the support arm off the rear. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack.
- \* If your bike is at the end, move the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- \* Close quickly to the curb.



The City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Ft. Lauderdale Community Shuttle Route. This community shuttle service will increase the number of destinations and transportation that can be reached through public transit. Destinations along the Fort Lauderdale LAS OLAS LINK Route include Broward Center for the Performing Arts, New River Park, Fort Lauderdale Beach, access to stores and restaurants along Las Olas Boulevard, and surrounding neighborhoods.

Connections are available to BCT routes 1, 11, 20, 20, and #3, Brightline Community Shuttle Bus connection to Brightline Link, Downtown Link, Neighborhood Link, and Northwest Community Link. Broward Metrorail, Florida's First Coastliner, SunRail, and Tri-Rail connections.

Connections on this route are as convenient and wheelchair accessible as a connection with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bike racks are also provided. Please refer to the pamphlet for instruction of how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

The Fort Lauderdale LAS OLAS LINK Route is free of charge, but users making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fare.

Delays may occur due to weather or other factors outside of our control, which may be longer than the expected travel time. Please allow yourself enough time when using the shuttle. The Fort Lauderdale LAS OLAS LINK Route need of assistance from another agency has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the shuttle. ### BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on the Fort Lauderdale Community Shuttle. Bike racks are designed to carry bicycles only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the shuttle approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any items that may fall off of it.

### Loading

- Always load your bike from the outside of the street.
- Lower/bend the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, swing the wheel into the arms of the instant position closest to the shuttle.
- Push/pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

### Unloading

- Always exit, hold the operator, you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack.
- If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- Give thanks to the curb.



It is important to have the opportunity to dismount before loading and unloading your bike. As the vehicle approaches, move your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

#### Loading

- Always hold your bike from the outside of the frame.
- Lower. Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the wheel lock.
- Get your bike into the rack. Align the wheels with the slots of the vacant position closest to the shuttle.
- Push/pull and rotate the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the handle or frame.

#### Unloading

- Before unloading, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack.
- If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- Move quickly to the bus.


