TITLE: Resolution Approving a License Agreement with the Florida Department of
Transportation for Right-of-Way Access to Intersections of State Road
A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard - Upgrades to Sidewalk Ramps

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution allowing the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to access City right-of-way (ROW) at intersections of State Road A1A (SR A1A)/Seabreeze Boulevard for the purposes of upgrades to the intersection sidewalk ramps within the project limits.

Background

FDOT has a resurfacing project along SR A1A from the Mercedes River Bridge to Sunrise Boulevard. This project will also include upgrades to the sidewalk ramps at intersections in order to meet the current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. In order to complete this work at intersections along SR A1A/Seabreeze Boulevard, FDOT requires a license agreement with the City to access property within City ROW at the cross-streets. This license agreement allows FDOT to enter, temporarily, onto City property for construction purposes only, and does not convey an easement or permanent rights to the property.

The resurfacing project is set to begin construction in February 2016. This agreement will be in effect until the completion of the resurfacing project, but no later than December 2020.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

Strategic Connection

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal city.
- Objective 1: Improve transportation options and reduce congestion by working with agency partners.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale 2035 Vision Plan: We Are Connected*.
