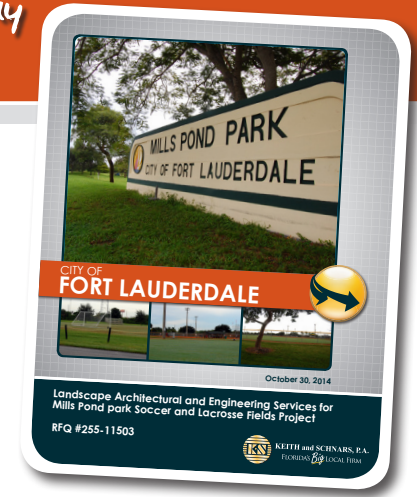

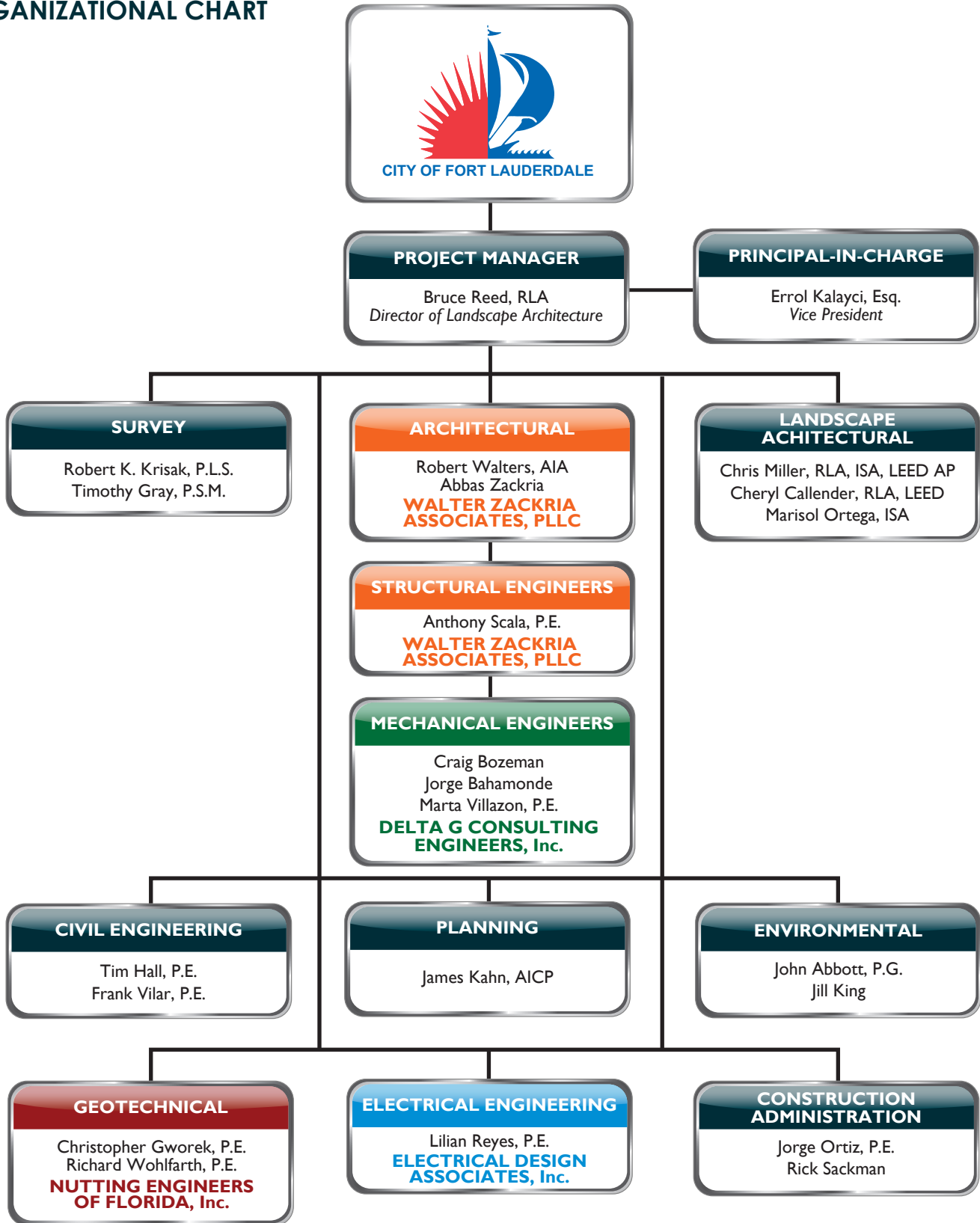

Keith and Schnars' involvement in the original plat work for the development of Windmill Park started in 1987 – then called Coco Parc. In 1990, Keith and Schnars prepared the original design work for the park, providing the City of Coconut Creek with master planning, site design, landscape, irrigation and parking design, construction inspection and administration services, as well as, overall project coordination assistance. The current park include active and passive recreation areas, bike, jogging and nature trails, picnic areas, playgrounds, ball fields, court games, entrance and park signage, wetland mitigation lakes and multi-purpose buildings.

Approach to Scope of Work

APPROACH

The City has a demand for additional soccer and lacrosse fields at the Mills Pond Park location. The City is implementing a comprehensive approach for the park improvements to effectively integrate the proposed elements. This approach will evaluate all aspects of the design and material selection considering major topics of cost, implementation, environmental impacts, functionality and maintenance. To implement this strategy the City will consult with a team of experienced professionals that will perform as an extension of staff to provide the best fit for the City and park users. This comprehensive approach will look at not only cost but value for the City.

The K&S Team will provide programming, design, material evaluations, schedules, site plan approval processing, permitting, bidding assistance, and construction administration to assist staff in the development of additional soccer and lacrosse fields and related elements.

This will include construction drawings, bid specifications and opinion of construction cost and would be submitted to the City after the K&S Team's quality control review comments had been satisfied.

Another critical phase in the life cycle cost of the project is the construction. A design can reflect all the appropriate provisions, address all of the site conditions, but if it is not constructed correctly the maintenance of that project may never meet the intent of the design - setting elements up for failure. K&S has been providing construction management and observation services for the majority of our municipal projects for over 15 years. We take special care to ensure all legal requirements are met in the construction process to ensure a smooth transition from design to implementation. 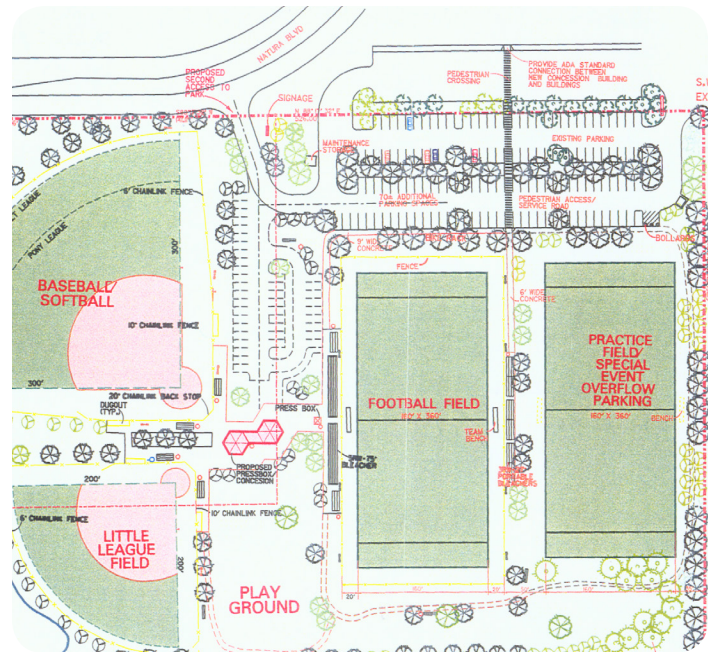

Mitchell Moore Park

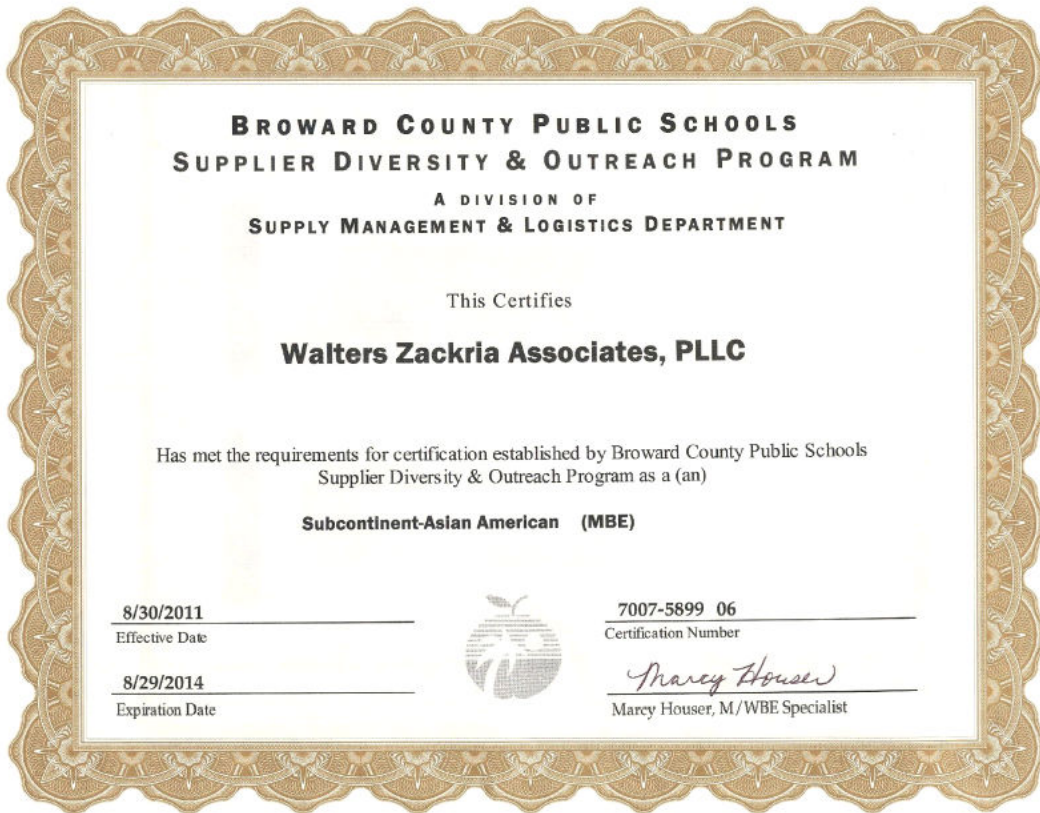


