TITLE: Resolution to dedicate portions of City-Owned Property as Public Right-of-Way for Purposes of the Wave Streetcar Project

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution (**Exhibit 2**) to dedicate portions of City-owned property as public right-of-way for purposes of the Wave Streetcar project.

BACKGROUND

During the development of the Wave Streetcar project, it was determined that portions of City-owned property along the route currently extend onto public right-of-way (ROW) into the street. As the Wave Streetcar nears final design and engineering, it is necessary to dedicate portions of City-owned property as public ROW (**Exhibit 1**) to accommodate the streetcar.

Resource Impact

There is no resource impact at this time.

Strategic Connections

This item is a Commission Annual Action Plan priority, included within the Management Agenda, advancing the Wave Streetcar project and the Downtown Walkability Program.

This is also a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- **Goal 1:** Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.
- **Objective 1:** Improve transportation options and reduce congestion by working with agency partners.
- **Initiative 3:** Work with partners to construct the Wave Streetcar, including the Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) ordinances and connections to airport, port, and rail stations.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale 2035 Vision Plan*: We are connected.
