## **RESOLUTION NO. 13-202**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FY2011 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT VIA THE CITY OF MIAMI.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$9,356,839 through the FY2011 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the urban area is defined as the Miami and Fort Lauderdale area collectively; and

WHEREAS, the sponsoring and coordinating agency for the grant is the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$9,600 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, such grant funds will be used for a regional training course on Advanced Hazmat Management Site Control;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the proper City Officials are hereby authorized to accept grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security UASI Grant Program through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management via the City of Miami in the amount of \$9,600.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
