

RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DOWNTOWN FORT LAUDERDALE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE AND TRANSIT SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT FOR ONE YEAR, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida (the "City") and the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association, Inc. ("TMA") entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") for TMA to operate the City Community Bus services; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the ILA was from October 1, 2014 through and including September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2015, the parties entered into a First Agreement to the Interlocal Agreement that added the Uptown Link transit route to the Community Bus Services provided by TMA; and

WHEREAS, Article 4 of the ILA provides that the term of the Agreement may be extended for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the ILA was extended for one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the ILA will expire on September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the ILA for an additional one (1) year period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. The City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby approves a one (1) year extension of the Interlocal Agreement for Community Bus and Transit Services with the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association, Inc.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association, Inc. to extend the Interlocal Agreement for one (1) year.

SECTION 4. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. That if any clause, section, or other part of this resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
