TITLE: Motion Authorizing Professional Services for City Hall First Floor Security Enhancements – Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC. – \$24,964 Task Order

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a task order (Exhibit 1) for architectural and design services for the City Hall first floor security enhancements with Synalovski Romanik Saye, LLC (SRS), in the amount of \$24,964.

Background

This project will address concerns regarding access and security on the first floor of City Hall, while also providing aesthetic improvements. This project includes the demolishing and relocation of the existing security desk and improving the waiting areas for the City’s neighbors. Also, existing lighting conditions will be assessed for possible improvements.

Staff has negotiated a task order and associated fees with SRS to provide design services not-to-exceed the amount of \$24,964.

This task order is being entered in pursuant to the General Architectural Consulting Services Agreement with SRS, approved by City Commission on August 19, 2014 (CAM #14-0896, RFQ No. 936-11270 “MASTER AGREEMENT”). The scope of services for the task order includes, but is not limited to, architectural design, mechanical engineering, electrical and low voltage engineering, and interior design services.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$24,964 for the task order.
