TITLE: Motion to Request Authorization to Join Two Class Action Lawsuits Against

Big Pharma - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission authorize the City to join two class action lawsuits against Big Pharma for pricing schemes related to generic drugs and insulin products.

Background

City Staff was approached by Ventura Law in January of 2024 to join two class action lawsuits related to the overpricing of generic drugs and insulin products. Ventura Law is the law firm that is leading the litigation action on these lawsuits. The goal of the law firm is to recover costs related to the overpricing of generic drugs and insulin products for self-insured government entities, such as the City. According to available data, the City has spent approximately \$9 million in generic drugs and \$2 million for insulin products since 2012. It is projected that it could take up to 5 years for these cases to be finalized. It was however advised that the generics lawsuit may be done sooner as it is further along in the litigation stages, while the insulin case is still in the early stages. As these lawsuits will be handled on a contingency basis, there is no financial impact to the City for the cost of attorney fees.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the City.
