Recommendation

It is recommended the City Commission approve a motion authoring the proper City officials to execute a Subordination, Non-Disturbance and Attornment Agreement for property located at 1500-1600 Northeast 12 Terrace.

Background

The property at 1600 Northeast 12 Terrace, Bay #3 (or Unit 4) is at present under lease to the City and is being used for the purpose of storing evidence and confiscated items. The landlord has made or will be entering into a loan agreement with Fieldpoint Private Bank & Trust secured by the mortgage. The parties have requested the City approve a Subordination, Non-Disturbance and Attornment Agreement.
