### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving and ratifying a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Teamsters Local 769 (Teamsters) effective October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2028.

#### Background

The previous Teamsters CBA expires on September 30, 2025. The City and Teamsters began negotiations for a successor agreement in May 2025 and met five (5) times. Through these negotiations, the City and the Teamsters came to a tentative agreement for a three (3)-year contract commencing on October 1, 2025, and expiring on September 30, 2028. The tentative agreement was presented to the Teamsters membership for ratification and Teamsters advised the City that the respective employees voted to ratify the agreement.

### **Resource Impact**

The estimated FY 2026 impact of this agreement is \$4,778,994. Funding required to implement this contract is included in the FY 2026 Budget.
