TITLE: A Motion Authorizing Execution of the Second Amendment to the Revocable License with Florida Power & Light Company for the Temporary Closure of the Public Right-of-Way on Aurelia Place

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the execution of a Second Amendment to the Revocable License with Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) for the temporary closure of the public right-of-way on Aurelia Place.

Background

On February 7, 2017 the City Commission authorized the execution of a Revocable License with FPL for a partial right-of-way closure on Aurelia place immediately west of Idlewyld Drive. The closure was needed to facilitate directional bore operations for relocating an FPL duct bank under the Intracoastal Waterway. This relocation was required by the Florida Inland Navigation District in advance of their Intracoastal Waterway dredging project.

On May 16, 2017, the City Commission authorized the execution of a First Amendment to the Revocable License that extended the term by five months to November 15, 2017. Subsequently, due to the impacts of Hurricane Irma last September, the City Manager granted two 30-day extensions through January 15, 2018.

FPL has recently indicated that they anticipate construction will be completed by the spring of 2018 and requested approval of a Second Amendment to the Revocable License to extend the term to May 15, 2018.

The limits of the License Area, the traffic detour plan, and all other provisions of the original Revocable License will remain the same. FPL will be required to provide written notice to property owners within 300 feet of the construction site to advise them of the new completion time.

A copy of the Second Amendment to the Revocable License is attached as Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this action.

Strategic Connections
