TITLE: Resolution Approving Fiscal Year 2024 Not-For-Profit Contribution Agreement with Carlton B. Moore Freedom Foundation, Inc., - \$5,000 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2024 Not For Profit Contribution Agreement with Carlton B. Moore Freedom Foundation, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, and authorizing execution of the agreement.

Background

According to its website,

The Carlton B. Moore Freedom Foundation, formed to honor the former longtime Fort Lauderdale city commissioner, plans to help inmates who may have been treated unfairly because of mandatory minimal sentencing. The foundation also wants to raise money for scholarships and educational programs for students in the Fort Lauderdale community.

Commissioner Moore served on the City Commission from 1988 to 2008.

City funds will be used to cover costs associated with the 4th Annual Carlton B. Moore Friends & Family Day. This event will take place at Osswald Park, 2220 NW 21st Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311 on October 7, 2023, and will feature live music, a bid whist tournament, a three-point basketball contest, food trucks, a kids' zone, and vendors' marketplace.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the General Fund in the amount of \$5,000 in FY 2024. Funding is budgeted and available in the account listed on the following page.
