TITLE: Second Reading - Ordinance Amending the Classification Table of the Pay Plan of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, by Establishing One New Classification - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt an ordinance amending the Classification Table of the Pay Plan by establishing one (1) new classification.

Background

With the recent opening of the new Police Department Headquarters, the Police Department now requires a Range Master which will oversee the operation of the indoor firearms range present at the new facility.

New Classification:

- Range Master (NB232) - Classified - Pay Grade G007

The first reading of the ordinance was held by the City Commission on July 2, 2026. The City Commission unanimously approved the ordinance without modifications.
