### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the ranking and authorize the commencement of contract negotiations for engineering consulting services for a comprehensive utility strategic master plan with the top ranked proposer Reiss Engineering, Inc. and certify them as qualified pursuant to law and the City's regulations as well as fully qualified to render the required services based on the City staff's recommendation.

## **Background**

The City solicited engineering firms to provide engineering consulting services for a comprehensive utility strategic master plan. The scope of services includes a comprehensive evaluation of the City's facilities, operations and procedures for delivery of water, wastewater and reclaimed water services.

The timeline for the solicitation process included the following:

- June 2014 RFQ 246-11426 was opened and four proposals were received from the following firms: Reiss Engineering, Inc., URS Corporation Southern, CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. and MWH Americas, Inc.
- July 2014 The evaluation committee consisting of Jorge Holguin Senior Project Manager, Pedram Zohrevand Assistant City Engineer, Tamira Coffman Assistant Public Works Director, Nancy Gassman Assistant Public Works Director and Samantha Timko Strategic Initiatives Administrator met with James Hemphill Sr. Procurement Specialist to evaluate and rank the proposers. As a result of the evaluation, the committee selected the following three firms to be shortlisted for oral presentations: Reiss Engineering, Inc., CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. and MWH Americas, Inc.

8/19/14 14-0917  July 2014 – Each firm was invited to make an oral presentation to the evaluation committee. After the presentations were completed, the committee ranked the proposals based on the evaluation criteria and oral presentations as shown in the following table.
