TITLE: Motion to award a proprietary purchase of T2 Flex Enforcement software and maintenance - \$41,580

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award the proprietary purchase from T2 Systems, Inc. for the purchase of T2 Flex Enforcement software and maintenance, in the amount of \$41,580.

Background

The Parking Services Division of the Transportation and Mobility Department currently uses the T2 system to handle a majority of processes involved with parking citation processing and collection. The handhelds that the Parking Enforcement Specialists currently use are old, out of warranty and will not provide the functionality that is currently needed. A purchase was recently made to replace all eleven devices with new Motorola MC9500 units. This proprietary purchase, in the amount of \$29,298 for the T2 Flex Enforcement software and \$12,282 for three years of maintenance, for a total cost of \$41,580, is to be used to operate the Motorola MC9500 parking citation handheld devices.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$41,580.
