TITLE: Resolution Approving Budget Amendment – Return Central City Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Fund Balance for Reallocation - **(Commission District 2)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board of Commissioners approve the return of \$703,999 Fiscal Year-end estimated Central City CRA fund balance to the City of Fort Lauderdale for reallocation back to the Central City CRA for Fiscal Year 2023 expenditures.

Background

At the end of Fiscal Year 2022, the Central City CRA Area has an estimated year-end balance of \$703,999.

The City of Fort Lauderdale is the sole taxing authority contributing Tax Increment Financing (TIF) to the Central City CRA. Subsection 163.387(7), Florida Statutes provides the following:

On the last day of the fiscal year of the community redevelopment agency, any funds which remains in the trust fund after the payment of expenses shall be:

- (a) Returned to each taxing authority which paid the increment in the proportion that the amount of the payment of such taxing authority bears to the total amount paid into the trust fund by all taxing authorities for that year;
- (b) Used to reduce the amount of any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged;
- (c) Deposited into an escrow account for the purpose of later reducing any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged; or
- (d) Appropriated to a specific redevelopment project pursuant to an approved community redevelopment plan. The funds appropriated for such project may not be changed unless the project is amended, redesigned, or delayed, in which case the funds must be re-appropriated pursuant to the next annual budget adopted by the board of commissioners of the community redevelopment agency.

Since the City of Fort Lauderdale is the sole taxing authority contributing TIF to the Central City Area, the CRA recommends returning the unspent paid increment to the City for reallocation back to the Central City Area to be used to further goals and objectives of the Central City Redevelopment Plan.
