**TITLE**: Motion to award a one-year contract for liquid chlorine in rail cars –

Invitation to Bid (ITB) 442-11382 - \$444,690

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a one-year contract for the purchase of liquid chlorine in rail cars to the single bidder, Allied Universal Corp., utilizing the City's Contract (Form P-0001), in the estimated annual amount of \$444,690 and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

### Background

During the water treatment process, chlorine is added to the finished water which provides a disinfectant residual that is sustained throughout the distribution system. The disinfectant residual must be maintained as per the Broward County Department of Health and Florida Department of Environmental Protection regulations.

On February 13, 2014 the Procurement Services Division issued an ITB and received one response. Allied Universal Corp. is the only vendor in south Florida that can supply the quantities of chlorine needed by railcar to the City. They are also the City's current vendor for chlorine and have provided excellent service.

## **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$200,000 in Fiscal Year 2014. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
